

- 4. Remember to stay safe!





What to do if I hear a fire alarm?

- Stop what you are doing
- Look and listen to your teacher or parent
- Calmly leave the building by following your evacuation plan
- Go to your waiting destination

What do I do if I am burned?






What do I do if I am burned?

- Ouch! The fire touched your skin and you got burnt!
- Immediately put your burned skin under cold water.
- Tell an adult so that they can help you treat the burn.

What do I do if I smell smoke?

- If you are in a room that fills with smoke, it will be difficult to breathe and see.
- You will start coughing if you breathe in the smoke.
- Go down on the floor and crawl out of the room. You will be able to see and breath better under the smoke.
- Once you are out of the room, run to safety.

What do I do if I am on fire?







What do I do if I am on fire?

- Oh no! Your clothing touched the fire and now your clothes are burning!
- Stay calm and go down on the floor.
- Roll back and forth over the fire to put it out.
- Keep rolling over the fire until it goes out.

- Make a map of your school. Mark every exit.
- Draw the quickest exit route to safety.
- Mark your waiting area.
- Keep it somewhere visible!

Role of a firefighter

- Firefighters work to keep people safe.
- They wear a uniform and equipment to keep themselves safe from dangerous fire.
- They are called for all kinds of dangerous situations (fire, floods, or car crashes).
- They drive big trucks with special equipment for helping people.
- Make sure you listen to their instructions.
