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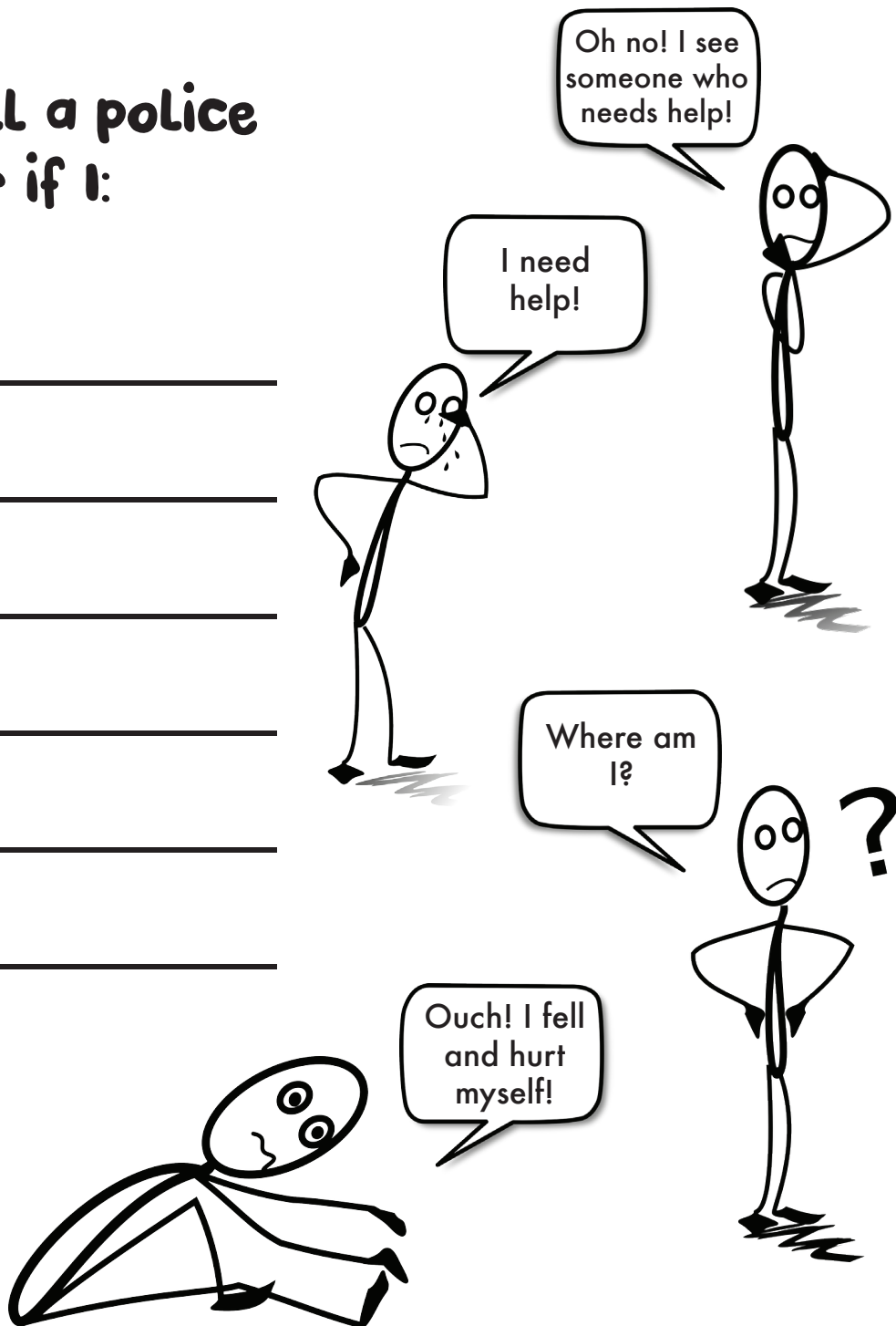
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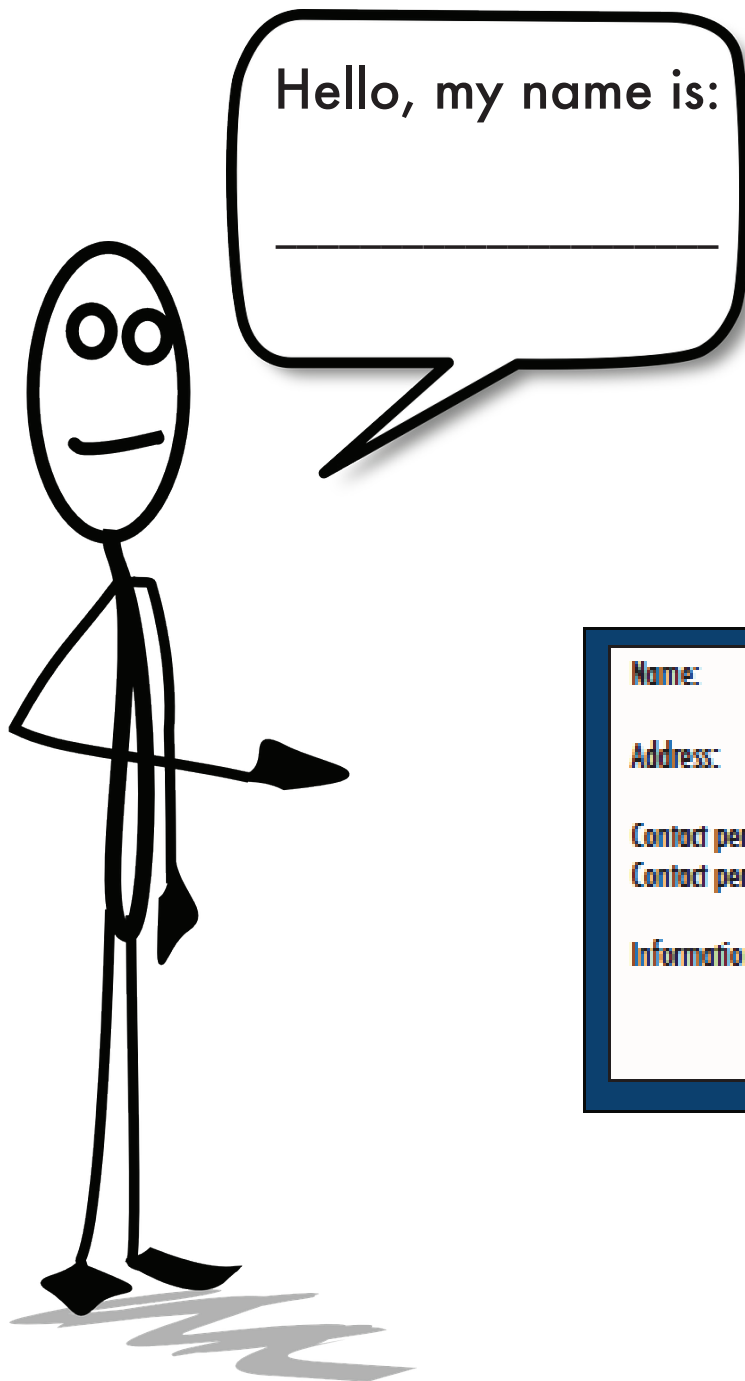
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## Identifying myself

Do I live in a house or an apartment? What is my street name? These are important information to tell a police officer. Practice writing your address so you are ready in case of an emergency.



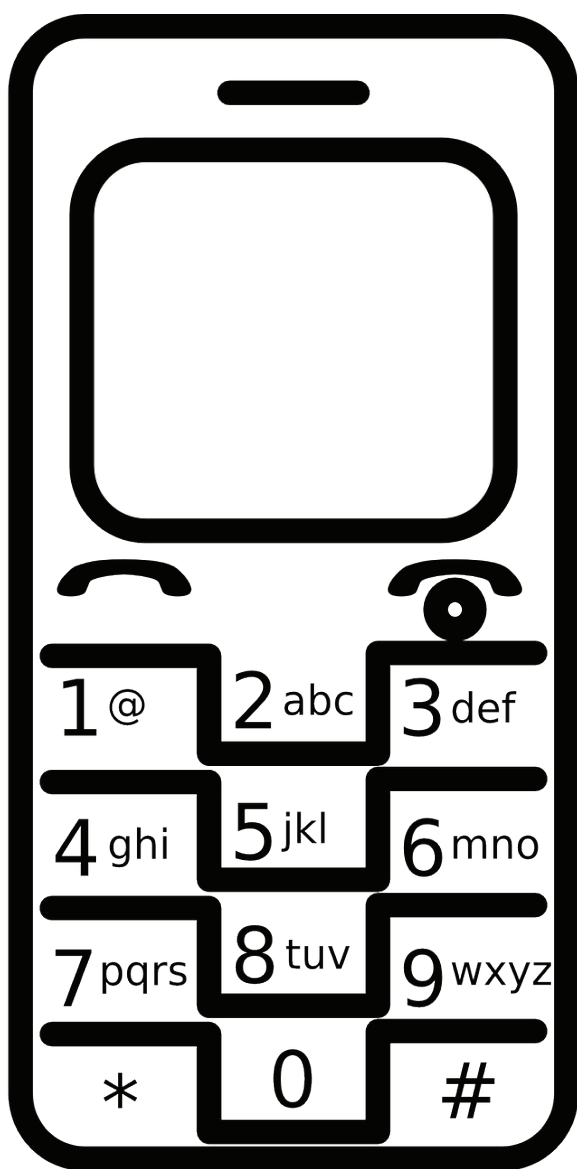

Circle the people you can trust.



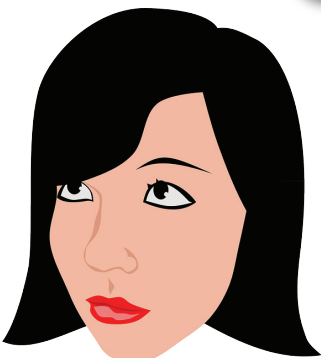
Hi! I'm a police officer. Do you need help with anything?
